According to a recent survey done by our Sri Lankan Coordinator, out of the 37 students in the first batch who were awarded scholarships in 1998, 22 have entered university! One of them is now an MBBS doctor!

Message from the Patron ...

Since its inception in 1998. Sri Lanka Canada Scholarship Foundation has come a long way. Up to now, the foundation has granted scholarships to over 100 grade 11 and 12 students, selected from various corners of Sri Lanka. The selections were done by the board of directors of the foundation with their unanimous agreement, purely based on the students' academic excellence and annual income of the family. Up to now, the selected students have received either 10 or 9 distinctions in their first sitting of the GCE Ordinary Level examination. The annual income (as certified by the Grama Sevaka of the area) of the selected students' family has been typically few thousand rupees in most cases. So, as sponsors of these scholarships, you can be really happy that you have helped many brilliant students with financial hardships in continuing their education. You will also be happy to learn that many of these students have entered the Sri Lankan universities. In addition to the scholarships, the foundation has also accomplished the following using any additional savings resulting from higher foreign exchange rates and other special donations:

- Distribution of library books to selected rural schools with minimal library facilities
- Distribution of school supplies to students with financial hardships

With your continued generosity, we can continue to provide these scholarships and other forms of help to needy Sri Lankan students. As we do not use your donations for any promotional material or advertising campaigns for the foundation (unless specific donations are made for these purposes), we depend on you to let your friends know about this worthwhile cause and be a part of it.

Establishment of Ranjan de Silva Memorial Scholarship Fund ************

Mr. Ranjit de Silva, Mrs. Dora de Silva and Ms. Liza de Silva in Vancouver, British Columbia, have established the Ranjan de Silva Memorial Scholarship Fund in 2002, in memory of late Mr. Ranjan de Silva. The de Silva family has entrusted the Sri Lanka Canada Scholarship Foundation to administer this scholarship fund on their behalf and select suitable recipients annually.

This fund will be used to award scholarships to one or more first year Engineering Faculty student(s) in Sri Lankan Universities for a period of one year. A monthly award of Rs 1000.00 will be provided for one year to each of the selected students. The main selection criteria will be the financial status of the student's family and the academic excellence of the student, based on the results of the G.C.E. A/L examination. Applications will be called annually through Sri Lankan news papers.
