Letters from our Scholarship Recipients

In the following extracted portions of letters written by students to their sponsors, students express how grateful they are to their sponsors for providing financial assistance. They all dream of a better future, with the determination of completing their studies successfully and helping other students, following the footsteps of their sponsors.

Note: We have removed names and addresses from these letters to maintain the anonymity of the students and their sponsors.

The following student's whole world is his family – mother, father and his brother. His father is a cancer patient for the past 10 years. About two years ago he was working at a newspaper distributing company, but since last July, he is hospitalized because his left lung had deflated.

His mother is working as a laborer in the hot sun, but her income is insufficient for their daily meals. Under these circumstances, he cannot describe how appreciative he is for the help he is getting from his sponsors. He considers them as an invisible god and expresses his utmost respect and love for them.

In the next letter, a student expresses how determined she is to study day and night despite all the difficulties she faces. Her father is a 53-year old laborer. He is a hero to her family, as he works rain or shine to earn a daily living.


In spite of all the financial difficulties and other shortcomings, she says they are fortunate enough to lead a happy, content life together!
